### \*Notes Pertaining to Academic Regulation for UG students

- 1. Attendance in all classes (lectures, tutorials, laboratories, workshops, etc.) is compulsory. A student may be debarred from appearing at an examination on ground of unsatisfactory attendance.
- 2. Absence from classes without prior permission will be considered as an act of indiscipline. Such cases will be dealt with in accordance with clause 3.5.
- 3. The students admitted to a Course leading to the B.Tech. (Hons.) degree in a particular branch will ordinarily be required to continue in that branch of studies.
- 4. However, the Institute may permit a few students, subject to their fulfilling the prescribed conditions, to change over from one branch to another, after two semesters of continuous studies. Detailed rules governing the change of branch are given in **Appendix IV** in B. Tech. regulation.
- 5. Every student admitted in the first year is required to register in the Extra Academic Activity (EAA) during the first four semesters.
- 6. Every student of the B.Tech. (Hons.) course is required to be present and register at the commencement of each semester on the day fixed for and notified in the Academic Calendar
- 7. A student may be debarred from appearing at the Mid-Semester or End-Semester Examination on the report of a subject teacher/ Head of the School , if his/her:
  - a. attendance at lecture/tutorial/laboratory classes has not been satisfactory during the period, and/or,
  - b. performance in the assignment works during the semester has not been satisfactory.
- 8. With a view to assist the students, who failed in one or more subjects in the autumn and/or spring semester in a year, a Summer Quarter will be conducted during the immediately following summer vacation for making up their deficiency and improve the performance. The regulations for running the Summer Quarter are given in **Appendix VIII** in B. Tech. Regulation.

9.

- i. A student has to clear  $2/3^{rd}$  of the registered credits (32 out of 48 credit) in  $1^{st}$  year (after supplementary examinations) to enable him/her to register for the  $2^{nd}$  year, failing which a student repeats the  $1^{st}$  year by registering for the subjects with grade F. The student may also register for some subjects with grade P to improve in CGPA.
- ii. If after repeating the 1<sup>st</sup> year, the student fails to clear the required credits (after the supplementary examination), he/she be asked to leave the Institute.
- iii. At the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> year, the student will have to clear all the 1<sup>st</sup> year subjects and in addition 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the credits of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year level registered subjects, failing which the student repeats the 2<sup>nd</sup> year.
- iv. The same rules as in (ii) and (iii) apply for promotion and discontinuation from 2<sup>nd</sup> year onwards.

### \*Notes Pertaining to Academic Regulation for PG Students

- 1. Attendance in all classes (lectures, tutorials, laboratories, workshops, etc.) is compulsory. A student may be debarred from appearing at an examination on ground of unsatisfactory attendance.
- 2. Absence from classes without prior permission will be considered as an act of indiscipline. Such cases will be dealt with in accordance with clause 3.5.
- 3. The students admitted to a Course leading to the M. Tech. degree in a particular branch will ordinarily be required to continue in that branch of studies.
- 4. Every student of the M. Tech. course is required to be present and register at the commencement of each semester on the day fixed for and notified in the Academic Calendar.
- 5. A student may be debarred from appearing at the Mid-Semester or End-Semester Examination on the report of a subject teacher/ Head of the School, if his/her:
  - a. attendance at lecture/tutorial/laboratory classes has not been satisfactory during the period, and/or,
  - b. performance in the assignment works during the semester has not been satisfactory.
- 6. (a) A student will continue his studies if he/she,
  - I. Clears 2/3rd of the registered credits in the 1<sup>st</sup> year to enable him to register for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, failing which the student repeats the First Year.
  - II. If the CGPA so calculated is less than that of 6.00 and 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the registered credits are cleared, the student is registered to complete the programme in slow pace
  - III. While registering for a subject, the student be permitted to register a different subject for elective, if desired.
  - b) The Institute assistantship of a student will be withheld in case a student fails in any subject. It will be restored only if SGPA/CGPA is at least 6.0 AND there is no 'F' grade following the supplementary examination. The student may however, continue without assistantship after supplementary examination with 'F' grade/grades, subject to the provisions contained in Clause -12.4 (a).
  - c) A student can appear for Supplementary Examination in the subject(s) concerned to be held in the School once a year during June/July and after that only the CGPA be calculated. In supplementary examination the student will be given one grade lower than the actual performance grade except in the case of Grade 'P' which will remain unchanged. The student will apply in a prescribed form together with necessary fees in order to appear in the supplementary examination.
  - d) Students with 'F' grades also have an option to re-register for the subject(s) in which they had failed in the following Autumn Semester or Spring Semester in which the subjects are offered. In such a case they will be entitled to full credit according to performance at the examination.
  - e) Students who have obtained CGPA lower than 6.00 may be allowed, on the recommendation of the Head of the School and with the approval of Dean (Academic Affairs) to re-register in one or more subject(s) in which he/she has received 'P' grade(s), so as to improve his/her CGPA to 6.00 or above by registering in the subject in the semester whenever it is offered. The availability of the course/faculty and a slot in the time-table is to be ensured by the concerned student/faculty advisor before registration in such subject(s) for grade improvement. This additional facility in any way, should not affect the total duration of the programme and graduation requirement mentioned under the provisions of clause-14. The grades will be revised and recorded only if there is an improvement over the existing 'P' grade.
  - f) Any change of grade of a student in a subject, consequent upon detection of any genuine error of omission and/or commission on part of the concerned teacher, must be approved by the School Academic Committee and must be forwarded by the teacher/chairman, co-ordination committee, through the Head of the concerned School within 20 (twenty) days from the date of commencement of the next Semester.
  - 7. In order to qualify for M. Tech. degree of the Institute, a student must:
    - (a) have completed all the credit requirements for the degree, which is prescribed as minimum credits by the concerned School, with grade 'P' or a higher grade in each of the subjects etc., for which the student had registered in all the semesters,
    - (b) have obtained a CGPA of 6.00 or more at the end of the semester in which the student completes all the requirements (including the project dissertation/thesis), for the degree.
