







IIT's admission process for masters underway

IT Bhubaneswar has started its admission process for 14 branches in Masters of Technology. The process of shortlisting candidates will begin after April 5. The selection procedure is likely to be held from July 19 to 20.

M.Tech Admission process is done through Common Offer Acceptance Portal (COAP). The entrance exam is conducted through GATE-Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering. Some of the key disciples for masters at IIT Bhubaneswar include Climate Science and Technology; Electronics and Communication Engineering; Power System Engineering; Power Electronics and Drives; Structural Engineering; Transportation Engineering; Environmental Engineering, among others.

Last year, some new courses were introduced including masters in Geotechnical Engineering, Manufacturing Engineering and Power Electronics and Drives.
