Prime Minister's Research Fellows (PMRF) Application

Cycle9 : Instructions to Applicants

Admission to PMRF is a three-stage process :

Stage 1: Nomination : PMRF Granting institutes send their nominations of eligible PhD Scholars through the PMRF portal.

Eligibility Criteria : https://www.pmrf.in/guidelines

Stage 2: Recommendation by National Panel

Step1 : Nominated PhD scholars apply through the PMRF Portal with details.

(For Details : See Annexure 2)

Step2 : Details of applications are sent to the Nodal Coordinators, who further formulate the subject panels and get the applications reviewed independently.

Stage 3: Final Selections by NCC based on the ranks and the number of seats allocated for each PMRF granting institutes, approved by NCC

Kindly note that the following timelines are to be adhered to strictly.

Timelines :

- 30 July 2022 : Portal opens and Institute coordinators can start uploading nominations.
- 16 Aug 2022 : Deadline for nominations to be submitted by PMRF granting Institutes
- 17 Aug 2022 : PMRF Portal opens for applicants, nominated applicants will be given login instructions on email
- 29 Aug 2022 : Submission deadline for applicants (detailed SoP/RP/Grade Cards etc to be submitted in the portal)
- 4 Sep 2022 : Deadline for recommenders to submit the recommendations in the portal
