Dr. Anil K Rajvanshi is currently Director of the Nimbkar Agricultural Research Institute (NARI), Phaltan, Maharashtra. Prior to taking this position he served as faculty at the University of Florida, USA. He did his BTech, MTech from IIT Kanpur and Phd from University of Florida in mechanical engineering. Dr. Rajvanshi has more than 35 years of experience in renewable energy research, rural and sustainable development. He has more than 150 publications and 7 patents to his credit.

His Areas of Specializations are:

Solar Distillation; Heat Transfer; Solar Energy Thermal Processes; Biomass Gasification and Combustion; Biomass Power plants; Electric Vehicles; Rural Energy R&D and Policy; Sustainable Development and Spirituality.

For his contributions, he received many awards which includes:

Padma Shri in 2022; Inducted in prestigious U.S. based Solar Hall of Fame(1998); Jamnalal Bajaj Award for Application of S&T for rural areas(2001), given by Dr. Manmohan Singh; FICCI Annual Award for Rural Development(2001-02); received the award on behalf of NARI from Prime Minister Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee; Energy Globe Award for motor assisted cycle rickshaw(MAPRA) (2004); Globe Forum Award for ethanol lanstove(2009), given by HRH princes Victoria in Stockholm, Sweden.

Dr. Rajvanshi served as Member of various core-committees related to rural technologies and policies of Govt. of India. Dr. Rajvanshi has lectured and given seminars at many leading Universities in India and USA. He has been interviewed and featured in many national and international magazines.
