Medical cards were also distributed among the attending villagers to facilitate future healthcare needs.

The camp was efficiently staffed with a team comprising 25 dedicated volunteers, 2 doctors, 2 nurses, and 1 pharmacist. Meals were generously provided at the guest house to nourish the participants throughout the day. A total of 101 patients availed themselves of the medical services during the event.

Later in the afternoon, the Director and Registrar joined the proceedings. The Director engaged in a meaningful dialogue with the villagers and led a session dedicated to women's health awareness, alongside his wife. The event concluded at 5 pm, leaving a positive impact on the health and well-being of the local communities.



I. Solar Light Installed in Podapada Village

On August 25, 2023, a solar-powered light was successfully installed in Podapada village. The installation ceremony was attended by the village's Ward (01) member and numerous villagers. Dr. Seema Bahinipati, the dedicated Coordinator of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), graced the occasion and engaged in a productive discussion with the local residents.
