Report on Event on National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 Sensitization

UBA team have conducted two webinars consecutively on 21.09.2020 and 22.09.2020 in order to sensitise UBA volunteers and villagers residing in the adopted villages about the proposals of National Education Policy 2020. About 15 participants joined the meeting on both the days. The residents of Khudupur and Sundaria villages attended the meeting. The parents and school teachers participated in the discussion, in addition to the volunteers and villagers. The main focus of the webinar talk was school education.

21.09.2020: This event was mainly focussed on informing our UBA team members about the National Education Policy 2020 and chalk out the theme of discussion with the people from adopted villages. We had the event with about 20 members from our team.

22.09.2020: This event was mainly focussed on informing about the National Education Policy 2020 to the people from the adopted villages. About 15 people, including Sarpanch, Sundaria village, parent and teacher from Khudupur village joined the event. We had an engaging discussion after the talk was delivered. People from the adopted villages appreciated the features in the policy. Parents expressed their concerns about the quality of education imparted in the Government schools. Teachers stressed upon the need to recruit more teachers and staff for the schools. The need to ensure a method to monitor the attendance of students was also stressed upon.
