IIT Bhubaneswar, in collaboration with CHC Jatni, launched a Pulse Polio Drive, inoculating 76 children. A model of community health and inclusivity.



In a significant community health initiative, the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Bhubaneswar, in partnership with the Community Health Centre (CHC) Jatni, launched an Intense Pulse Polio Immunization Drive from 3rd to 5th March 2024. This effort resulted in the administration of Pulse Polio Drops to 76 children under the age of 5, encapsulating the commitment of both institutions towards public health and welfare. During the drive, the Sanjeevan



Health Centre of IIT Bhubaneswar became the focal point for the vaccination campaign, catering not only to the children of the institute's faculty and staff but also extending its reach to include children from surrounding areas and the migrant workers' colony within the campus. చిన్నారులకు పోలియో చుక్కలు వేస్తున్నా దృశ్యం

భువనేశ్వర్: స్థానిక భారతీయ సాంకేతిక సంస్థ (ఐఐఐటీ) ఆధ్వర్యంలో పోలియో చుక్కల కార్యక్రమం విజయవంతంగా నిర్వహించారు. క్యాంపస్ సిబ్బంది పిల్లలతో పాటు ఈ ప్రాంగణంలో ఉంటున్న వలస కార్మికుల పిల్లలకు పోలియో చుక్కలు వేశారు. ఐఐఐటీ కమ్యూనిటీ హెల్త్ సెంటర్ (సీహెచ్ఎస్) సహకారంతో 3 రోజులపాటు నిర్వహించిన కార్యక్రమం మంగళవారంతో ముగిసింది. క్యాంపస్ ప్రాంగణంలో సంజీవన్ హెల్త్ సెంటర్ లో జరిగిన మూడు రోజుల పోలియో చుక్కల డ్రైవ్ లో 5 సంవత్సరాల కంటే తక్కువ వయస్సు ఉన్న 76

మంది పిల్లలకు పోలియో చుక్కలు వేశారు. సంజీవన్ హెల్త్ సెంటర్, ఐఐఐటీ సీహెచ్ఎస్ సభ్యులు క్యాంపస్ మరియు సమీప ప్రాంతాల నివాసితుల పిల్లలకు టీకాలు వేశారు.
