The English Language Lab is a 64-seater laboratory employing cuttingedge technologies to revolutionize technical and communicative English education to cater to the needs of students from diverse backgrounds. It primarily focuses on enhancing the listening, speaking, reading and writing (LSRW) abilities of the users while prioritizing student engagement by making learning fun, interactive and collaborative. The Lab will prove to be an invaluable aid in the teaching-learning practice of not only English language but for learning other languages too.
