	Board approved for the establishment of Kendriya Vidyalaya under IHL Sector project mode in IIT Bhubaneswar from the academic session 2022-23 in its 46 th meeting held on 05.07.20222 in the line with the approval of the Ministry of Education and guidelines issued by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), New Delhi. Board further approved for sanction of deposit of Rs.80 lakhs in the Escrow Account and proposed recurring expenses of Rs.1.2 crores (approx.) per annum from IRG in establishment of the KV at IIT Bhubaneswar.						
	However, it was observed during the FY 2023-24 that Rs.1.2 crores per annum is becoming insufficient. Last financial year's requirement was Rs.1.71 crores. The requirement of fund for KV will increase with increase in no. of classes like 10 th , 11 th and 12 th .						
	In view of the above, it was proposed to approve the recurring expenses to run K V at IIT BBS from IRG as per actual requirement.						
	The Board approved the above proposal upon recommendation of the FC.

As per the decision of the Board in its 16th meeting held on 02.12.2014 [Office Order No.92/2015 dated 11.02.2015], the delegation of financial power has been accorded to the Deputy Registrars/ Executive Engineers of the Institute up to an amount of Rs.25,000/- where the name of Deputy Librarian was not included. Therefore, it was proposed to accord financial authority up to Rs.25,000/- to the Librarian/Deputy Librarian also. The Board approved the proposal upon recommendation of the FC for extending financial authority up to Rs.25,000/- to the Librarian in the Institute. However, in the absence of the Librarian, Deputy Librarian will have the same authority. BoG:50-9 To consider Pay Protection to the following employees who joined IIT Bhubaneswar after submitting resignation in their previous organization without proper channel. (a) Prof. Sarat Kumar Panda, Professor, SIF (b) Shri Ravinandan Kumar Vaishya, Security Officer (a) Case of Prof. Sarat Kumar Panda, Professor, SIF:





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Dr. Sarat Kumar Panda had applied for the position of Professor without forwarding his application through proper channel. His application was considered and he was called for interview on 8th August 2022 (Monday) (email sent on 5th August 2022, Friday) with a stipulation to produce NOC at the time of interview. Dr. Panda reported for interview without NOC, and submitted a declaration that if he got selected he will submit NOC at the time of joining, else his candidature will be cancelled.

With the above declaration, he was allowed to appear interview and was selected for the post of Professor. Subsequently he was relieved from IIT (ISM) Dhanbad on 2nd January 2023 on resignation and joined IIT BBS on 3rd January 2023 submitting all documents including relieve order, but except NOC.

Since this was not a Technical Resignation, as per rule his pay was fixed at the initial without giving him pay protection, which is Rs. 12,600/- less in basic pay compared to his last pay in IIT (ISM) Dhanbad.

He requested for pay protection on the ground that he received the call letter after 5.30 PM on Friday followed by weekend and he had to appear interview on Monday. So, he did not have the time to apply for NOC and could not produce at the time of interview.

Board deliberated on the matter and decided to form a committee to frame a policy to deal with such cases where performance in this Institute will be the main criteria.

(b) Case of Shri Ravinandan Kumar Vaishya, Security Officer:

Shri Ravinandan Kumar Vaishya was working in BSF (Deputy Commandant, Pay Level-11) and had applied for the position of Security Officer (Pay Level -10) without forwarding his application through proper channel. The experience required for the post was more than 10 years experience in the rank of DSP/Captain in Army or its equivalent (Pay Level-10). His application was considered and was called to appear for interview on 12th January 2023 with a stipulation to produce NOC at the time of interview. He reported for interview without NOC, and was interviewed and selected.





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Before joining (on 14th March 2023) through email he enquired whether his pay will be protected providing his pay slip. He was replied that pay protection shall be given to an employee as per the Institute rules subject to submission of documents as mentioned in the Offer Letter.

Thereafter, he was relieved on 15th April 2023 from BSF and joined IIT BBS with all relevant documents as mentioned in the Offer letter and also he produced NOC where it is mentioned that Shri Vaishya was proceeding on voluntary resignation and there is no objection from the HQ on joining IIT Bhubaneswar as Security Officer.

Since it was mentioned that he was proceeding on voluntary resignation, his case was not treated as Technical resignation and his pay was fixed at initial which is Rs. 27,200 /- less in basic pay compared to his last pay in BSF.

He requested to protect his pay in view of the email communication on pay protection, submission of all documents as per offer letter and requirement of more than 10 years service at pay level - 10 for a post of pay level - 10.

Board deliberated on the matter in detail and decided to protect his pay at pay level -10. BoG also directed to amend the relevant clause of experience for Security Officer and similar cases in the RPP.

BoG:50-10

To discuss about the report of the Inquiry Committee on an article about suspected financial irregularities by Shri Debaraj Rath, Joint Registrar and Officiating Registrar of the Institute appearing in a local newspaper.

An article on the suspected financial irregularities by Shri Debaraj Rath, Joint Registrar and Officiating Registrar of the Institute was published in a local newspaper just before the selection interview for the position of Registrar for which he was an applicant. On complaint by Shri Rath, a committee was constituted by the Director to investigate the matter on how such an article was published in a local newspaper.

At the same time, on the basis of a complaint made by Dr. S. N. Routray, Asst. Registrar, the matter was also referred to the CVO of the Institute to examine the suspected financial irregularities by Shri Rath.



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The reports of the Committee and the CVO were placed before the Board.

The Board deliberated on both the reports in detail and decided to drop the complaints made against Mr. Debraj Rath and Dr. S. N. Routray by each other. Further, Board directed to look into the case of deduction of non-negotiable portion of pension in all cases of the Institute uniformly.

BoG:50-11

To discuss about the report of the Review Committee on the charges levelled against an Officer on the ground of disobedience and insubordination while discharging official duties.

The Board in its 47th meeting held on 14.09.2022 deliberated the report of the Preliminary Inquiry Committee on the charges levelled against Dr. S.N. Routray, Asst. Registrar on the ground of disobedience and insubordination while discharging official duties and directed to get it reexamine by constituting a Review Committee to establish the facts.

The report of the Review Committee along with the report of earlier committee was placed before the Board. The Board deliberated on both reports and decided drop the case, however with a displeasure. Further, Board directed to issue an appropriate letter of displeasure to Dr. S. N. Routray.

BoG:50-12

To consider the recommendation of DPC for promotion of Dr. S N Routray, Asst. Registrar.

Dr. S.N. Routray joined the Institute on 22nd May 2013 as Assistant Registrar. He has completed his normal residency period for the promotion from Assistant Registrar to the post of Deputy Registrar. Hence, the Departmental Promotion Committee met on 14th May 2024 to assess the proposal for his promotion as per relevant guidelines. He is due to retire on 30 June 2024.

However, a disciplinary case was levelled against him as detailed in the above agenda no. BoG: 50-11.

In view of the above, legal opinion was taken from Adv. Partha Sarathi Nayak, Sr. Counsel, Govt. of India, Odisha High Court on whether Dr.



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S.N. Routray be legally promoted to the post of Deputy Registrar if has been recommended by the Promotion committee with a pending disciplinary case, or should the promotion be put on hold until the resolution of the case.

The recommendation of the Departmental Promotion Committee along with legal opinion was placed before the Board for decision.

The Board approved the recommendation of the Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) in view of its decision vide resolution no. BoG:50-11 above.

BoG:50-13 To discuss on the Report of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) w.r.t. a complaint on sexual harassment by a girl student against a faculty member.

Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) of the Institute received a complaint of sexual harassment from a girl student against a faculty member on February 15, 2024. After detailed enquiry, ICC submitted its Report to the authority for its decision.

The Report of the ICC was placed before the Board for decision.

After detailed discussion of the Report, the Board advised to take up the case seriously and to ensure "Zero Tolerance" towards Sexual Harassment of women at workplace. Further, Board directed to ensure justice following due procedures.

BoG:50-14 To discuss on the Recommendation of the Institute Integrity Committee (IIC) regarding submission of forged / fabricated documents by Dr. P. Bera, Associate Professor, School of Electrical Sciences.

Dr. P. Bera joined IIT Bhubaneswar on 23 September 2013 as an Assistant Professor in the discipline of Computer Science & Engineering, School of Electrical Sciences. Subsequently, he was selected as Associate Professor w.e.f. 22 October 2022 and is under probation. It was reported to the Director that Dr. Bera submitted forged / fabricated documents while seeking financial approval of the competent authority on three different occasions. The matter was





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referred to the Institute's Standing Integrity Committee. The committee perused the documents available on record and observed that the above acts committed by Dr. Bera are improper and against the established norms of the Institute. Accordingly, Show-cause Notice was issued to Dr. Bera on 25 Apr 2024 for his above acts to which he admitted his mistakes and deeply apologized for the same.

The report of the Integrity Committee was put up before the Board for decision.

The Board deliberated on the Report and accepted the recommendation of the Integrity Committee for its implementation.

In respect of the observation of the CAG on the above matter, a committee was formed to finalize the claims of CES India Pvt. Ltd. The committee recommended recovery of ₹ 32.01 Lakhs from CES India Pvt. Ltd towards dismantling of certain portions of six buildings without statutory fire-fighting provisions.

Based on the recommendation of the committee, Institute has recovered by not paying ₹ 32.01 Lakhs from the bills of CES India Pvt. Ltd. Besides, the Institute has chosen not to pay CES India Pvt. Ltd ₹92.55 Lakhs for the design's failure to comply with statutory fire-fighting requirements.

Further, necessary statutory fire-fighting provisions had already been incorporated in all the buildings constructed under phase-II. However, same will also be ensured for upcoming new constructions at IIT Bhubaneswar.

In compliance to the 76th PAC (2023-24) report of Lok Sabha, above Action taken report has been sent to the MoE for their perusal and closure of the case.
