IIT Bhubaneswar has celebrated Utkal Divas in a grand manner. Chief Guest Prof. Basanta Kumar Panda, Project Director, Centre of Excellence for Studies in Classical Odia, Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL), Ministry of Education, Govt. of India graced the occasion, in the presence of Prof. Shreepad Karmalkar, Director, IIT Bhubaneswar and Shri Bamadev Acharya, Registrar of the Institute.





Prof. Karmalkar delivered his entire speech in Odia even if his mother tongue is not Odia. He described his experience in Odisha during more than two years of his stay in Odisha.
