**IIT Bhubaneswar joins the Nation in celebrating
the 77th Republic Day**

Bhubaneswar, 27th January 2026: Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Bhubaneswar has joined the Nation in celebrating the 77th Republic Day with patriotic fervour, aligned with the national theme of the year: Swatantrata ka Mantra: Vande Mataram and Samridhhi ka Mantra: Aatmanirbhar Bharat. Prof. Shreepad Karmalkar, Director, IIT Bhubaneswar unfurled the National Flag on the occasion.

In his address, Prof. Karmalkar emphasised that *“developing the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform”* and *“striving towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity”* are duties of citizens enshrined in Article 51A of Part IV A of India’s constitution.
